## **VECHILES**

All vehicles must be out of the park 30 minutes **before** the opening of the festival and no vehicles will be allowed to enter the park until 15 minutes **after** the festival closes each day to allow visitors to exit the park.

#### **ADMISSION PASSES**

Four (4) exhibitor tickets will be to each vendor. These tickets will be your admission tickets to the festival and will be turned into the workers at the gates as you enter the fairgrounds each day. Please remember you are to give the gate worker your pass **EACH day** and they will stamp your hand which allows you to leave the park and return all day then.

## **SCHEDULE**

Dealers must participate in **both** days. All booths are to be open from 10:00 AM to 6:00PM on Saturday and from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM on Sunday. **NO MERCHANDISE IS TO BE SOLD**TO THE PUBLIC BY ANY DEALER BEFORE THE FESTIVAL OPENS EACH DAY. No teardown will be permitted before 5:00 PM on Sunday.

## **COSTUMES**

<u>All participants</u> (this includes anyone sitting in your booth – spouses, and children) must be in pioneer costume, from opening to closing each day. Time period is 1800s — "Little House on the Prairie" style.
