SETUP:

You can set up your exhibit on Friday afternoon, or you can begin at 7:00 a.m. Saturday. No tear downs can begin before closing time on Sunday. Exhibits will be open from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday from 10:00 a.m. till 5:00 p.m. All vehicles are to be out of the area by 9:45 a.m. each day of the Festival. No vehicles will be allowed back into the park until 15 minutes after the festival closes each day to allow visitors to leave the festival. You are encouraged to park in the Swindler lot behind the cattle barns or in the lot on the corner of Evergreen and Taylor Streets.

PARKING:

Parking is available in any festival parking area. A limited number of passes are available for vendors to park in the Swindler lot area off Evergreen Road by the cattle barns and in vendor lot on the corner of Evergreen and Taylor Street. Please indicate interest for this pass on your Registration form (only one vendor parking pass will be given out to each participant).

ADMISSION:

Admission into the Festival is \$3.00 per adult, \$1.00 for students. Children 5 and under are free. An exhibitor will be issued one day passes for you and your workers (normally four (4) passes are given to each exhibitor). The workers' pass will be collected at the gate each day. On your Registration Form, please indicate how many you will need, keeping in mind that passes are valid for one day only.

Sunday morning worship service will begin at 9:00 a.m., and breakfast will be served at 9:00 also, on the grounds. There is a charge for the breakfast.

INSURANCE:

Every participate MUST have proof of Liability Insurance when you arrive at the festival before setting up.
